

## **West Deptford Police SLEO III Hiring Announcement**

The West Deptford Police Department is now accepting applications and resumes for the position of Class III Special Police Officer. The WDPD will be looking to hire Class III Special Police Officer/s for the upcoming 2022/2023 school year.

The West Deptford Township Police Department is currently seeking retired police officers to hire for the position of Class III Special Police Officer. The Class III Special Police Officer, under the direction of the Chief of Police, shall conduct school safety and security duties within the West Deptford Township School District. The Class III Special Police Officer will be compensated \$35 per hour and will only work on the days that school is in session and/or training days.

The applicants must meet the Minimum Pre-Certification Requirements as listed below:

1. Be a citizen of the United States
2. Be a resident of the State of New Jersey during his or her term of appointment to this position.
3. The applicant must be a retired law enforcement officer who has previously served as a duly qualified, fully-trained, full-time police officer in any municipality or county of this state, or as a member of the New Jersey State Police.
4. Must be retired from that agency in good standing (necessary to have a letter of good standing issued by the agency from which the officer retired, listing the date and type of retirement. A copy will be submitted to the NJ Police Training Commission).
5. Must be less than 65 years of age for appointment.
6. Must pass a psychological examination.
7. Must pass a medical exam and have doctor complete a Medical Certification form.
8. Must pass a Drug Test pursuant to the NJ Attorney General's Law Enforcement Drug Testing Policy.
9. Must have an updated background investigation.
10. Limited break in service: As of July 1, 2018, a new SLEO III's break in service may not exceed three (3) years.
11. Must successfully pass an oral interview.
12. All applicants offered a conditional offer of employment will be required to pass a medical examination, psychological examination, and drug screening.
